SNF6 featuredaRoll Call of the 51 MSDG Diaspora Fellows Launch of the GIEPA Diaspora Advice Desk & the 'Made in The Gambia' marketplace

- 550 people attended SNF6 in person, comprising:250 women(45%); 300 men (55%); 80 diaspora (15%); 175 aged under 35 years (32%); 375 (68%) aged over 35. The participants includedministers, parliamentarians, municipal leaders, diplomats, senior government officials, diaspora development practitioners, civil society and business professionals, senior academics, university students, media practitioners, and 'Made in The Gambia' producers and traders.
- The in-person diaspora participants are **currently based in 16 countries**, namely: Brunei, France, Germany, Italy, Kuwait, Malaysia, Nigeria, Netherlands, Norway, Qatar, Senegal, Spain, Sweden, UAE, UK and USA.**Over 5,000** people watched the live-stream mainly of the EyeAfrica TV facebook and youtube channels.
- 24 speakers, presenters and moderators (9 women [38%], 15 men [62%], 5 diaspora [20%]); the diaspora speakers being from Norway, United Arab Emirates (UAE); United Kingdom (UK)and United States of America (USA).
